Please also name all possessions this will help prevent items being mislaid.

Children's own toys are precious to them, we know they like the idea of bringing them in but please keep them out of preschool where there is a possibility of toys being mislaid or spoiled.

Your child's safety is very important to us... <u>Please do not park your</u> <u>car in our car park or use the car park to drop off or pick up your</u> <u>child at any time</u> as this puts other children, parents and staff at risk. Free parking is available at Waitrose for 11/2 hours. If you have a disability please speak to our manager.
